

This is a guide to show where to place patches on the scout uniform. Please check with the Scoutmaster if you have questions.

### Right Pocket



This patch, or any other temporary patch, should be centered on the pocket. Wearing a patch on this pocket is not required.



The Recruiter patch should be centered just below the bottom point of the pocket.

### Left Pocket (wearer's heart side)

The bottom edge of the World Crest patch should be centered 1-1/2 inches above the top of the pocket. →



The Rank patch should be centered on the pocket. Only their current rank should be worn. →



If earned as a Cub Scout, the Arrow of Light patch should be centered just below the bottom point of the pocket. →



↓ Green shoulder loops (aka epaulets)



↑ Troop 193 scouts choose to wear the bolo shown above, instead of a neckerchief.

### Right Sleeve

Comes sewn on uniform →



Your Patrol Patch (design will vary for each patrol) →



### Left Sleeve (wearer's heart side)



← Numerals should touch (if they are separate patches)



← Position Patch

**NOTE: Patches should almost touch. Don't leave too big of a space between patches.**



← A Scout's merit badge sash is worn diagonally from the right shoulder to the left hip, never on the belt, with badges arranged neatly on the front in three columns (or more if needed) starting a few inches down, and other event patches go on the back. It's for formal events like Courts of Honor, not campouts, and can't be worn with the Order of the Arrow sash simultaneously.
